Workshop Details: During the workshop, Faye will share information with writers on how to keep records required for filing a Business Income Tax Return; what expenses are deductible; how to complete a Schedule C [Profit or Loss from Business]; how to calculate Office in Home Expense; etc. She will use the actual Schedule C as a guide during the workshop, plus the schedule SE [Self-Employment Tax].

FAYE ADAMS is a freelance writer who has published three poetry chapbooks and four hardback books: A book of poetry, a children's book and two books of poetry and nonfiction. She also writes fiction, flash fiction, essays and memoirs. She has published work in newspapers, magazines, poetry journals, periodicals, and anthologies.

Faye has helped conduct poetry workshops in classrooms and for writers groups. She serves as Corresponding Secretary of the MSPS Poetry Chapter, "On the Edge," and has served Writers Society of Jefferson County as Secretary (2006) and Poetry Moderator (2005 & 2006).

She is currently the SLWG Rep. to MWG. and serves as the Contest Chair for the Big Write Contest for Kids. She was one of two featured poets at the Lucidity Poetry Retreat in Eureka Springs, AR in April, 2009

Faye holds membership in the Writers' Society of Jefferson County, the Missouri State Poetry Society, the Society of Children's Book Writers and Illustrators and the Missouri Writers Guild. She and her husband, Bill, are currently working on the seventh annual anthology of poetry and nonfiction being published by the De Soto chapter of MSPS, for which she serves as co-editor. She is currently editing two poetry books for a fellow writer, and recently served as copy editor for a patriotic poetry anthology. She is ready to begin as a ghost writer of a true crime novel, in cooperation with a Pine Lawn Policeman. Her second *Chester* book is now with the illustrator, and during the past year, Faye has written enough poems and stories to fill another book, if she ever gets time to put it together.
