About Ted Kooser:

One of the most distinguished writers of our time, Kooser is Presidential Professor of English at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. He has published twelve books of poetry, including *Delights and Shadows*, which won the Pulitzer Prize for Poetry in 2005.

Directions:

Maryville University is located on North Outer 40/I-64 Drive, between the Mason Road and Route 141. Exit at Maryville Center Drive) and take Maryville University Drive (the next turnoff from outer road west of the interchange). Turn left on the loop road and park in any General Parking area. The Library-Art Gallery (Reception), the Auditorium (Lecture) and the Buder Family Commons (Saturday Workshop) are located along this loop road. Campus walks connect all these buildings.
