LINDA O'CONNELL is a multi-genre writer who has been published in a variety of publications. Her personal essays have been published in the Chicken Soup book series, including *Chicken Soup for the Gardener's Soul*, *The New Mom's Soul*, and *The Beach Lover's Soul*. Her work has been featured in print, on line, in literary

journals and educational guides. She has also had numerous essays published in the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch*, *Chicago Tribune*, and *Suburban Journals*.

PETER H. GREEN, SLWG Vice President of Programs, is the author of *Dad's War with the United States Marines*, a family memoir compiled from the memories contained in 400 letters his father wrote from the South Pacific during World War II, along with his own childhood memories. He has also recently signed a contract for publication of his second book, *Crimes of Design*, a mystery novel.

BRAD COOK, SLWG Historian, has for the past two years overseen the Legacy Project, researching the history and past-presidents of the organization. He started as a playwright, but found a passion for novels and work as a consultant. Having written genre fiction and for the corporate world, he is well versed in a variety of writing and research techniques. As Reid Cook, he is a writer of epic fantasy and historical fiction, and is currently seeking representation for a series of Steampunk novels.
